



IVERSON ARCHITECTS HONORED WITH PRESTIGIOUS 2005 BEST OF SENIORS HOUSING AWARDS AND THE NATIONALS

Iverson Architects was recognized as among the “best of the best” in the seniors housing industry and in the nation with gold awards by the National Association of Home Builders (NAHB). The awards were presented during the 2005 Best of Seniors Housing Awards and The Nationals ceremonies held in January in Orlando, Florida.

The Cimarron Model at the Boulders at Sonoma Ranch, Las Cruces, New Mexico won in the Best of Seniors Housing Awards Category of Active Adult Home Design – 1,501

to 2,100 Square Feet. Another Boulders model, the Anton, won in the Nationals for Best Product Design under \$250,000.

With this year’s winners the total number of national design honors garnered by Iverson Architects for design of the homes and Community Center at the Boulders stands at eight, among them are two platinum Seniors Housing Awards and two Gold Nugget Awards given last year.
